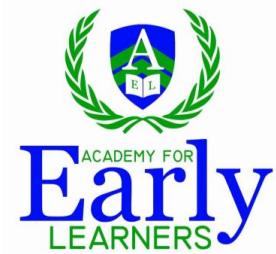


ACADEMY FOR EARLY LEARNERS FEE INFORMATION



At Academy for Early Learners, we offer 9-hour, 10-hour and full day sessions. This provides flexible options helping families to make the most of the Child Care Subsidy.

Fee rates*: The fee rate for **0-2 years** (Babies) is \$130 a day. The fee rate for **2-3 years** (Toddlers) is \$120 per day. The fee rate for children **3-6 years** (Preschoolers) is \$105 per day.

*All fees are subject to change at our discretion; notice of 4 weeks will be provided.

Designed to reduce the out of pocket expenses and increase access to subsidized hours, the following model maximizes our commitment to providing access to quality early childhood education and care

Choose which session suites your family the most:

	Nine – Hour Session*	Ten – Hour Session*	Full Day Session
Fixed Care Time Frame	8:00 am to 5:00 pm fixed session time.	7:30 am to 5:30 pm fixed session time.	Full day Centre operating hours. Parents choose start and finish times.
Grace Period	15 minutes	15 minutes	Not Applicable
Early drop off or late pick up charge (outside of grace period)	\$5 per 15 minutes each side	\$5 per 15 minutes each side	Not Applicable

Hourly Sessions are offered to allow families to maximize the CCS you receive. If you do not attend the full 10 hour session or 9 hour session the daily rate for each group will be charged regardless of any session hours attended. If you do not meet the exact 10 Hourly or 9 Hourly Session, there is a grace period for the sign in and sign out times of 15 minutes per side. If the grace period is exceeded the charge of \$5 will apply for every 15 minutes on top of the normal daily rate that applies to your child's age group.

We recommend speaking with the Centre Director if you have any queries regarding Hourly Sessions.

*Please be aware that your sign in and sign out times are defaulted to 9-hour and 10-hour periods in the day. This is however subject to change with the collection of your child via the QK kiosk sign in/out times.

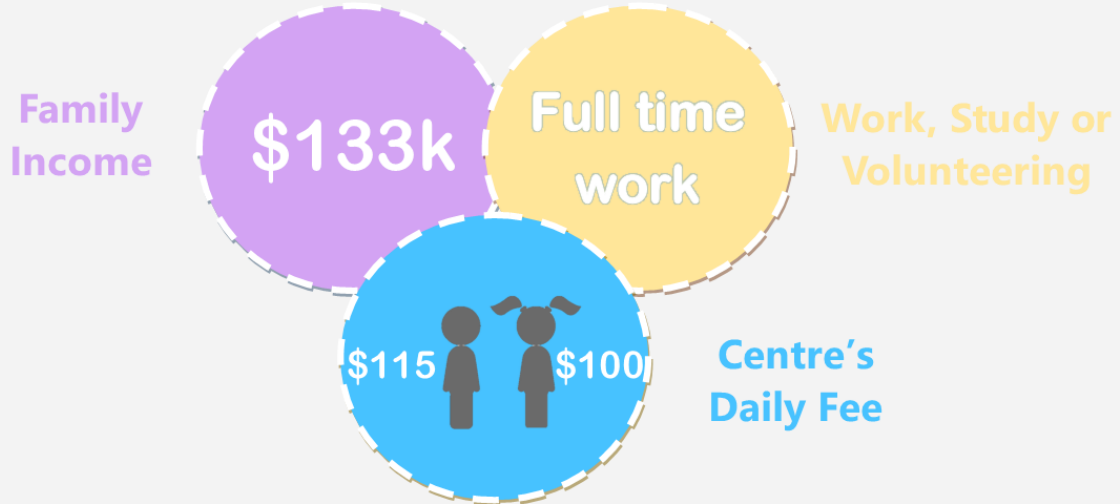
If failure to meet the 9- hour or 10-hour sessions occurs, the service reserves the right to disallow this hourly option.

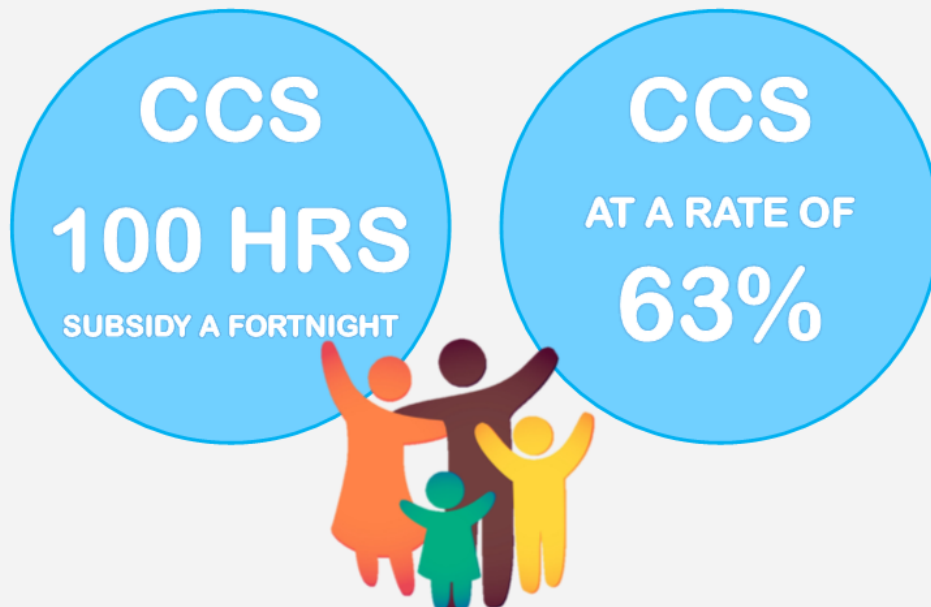

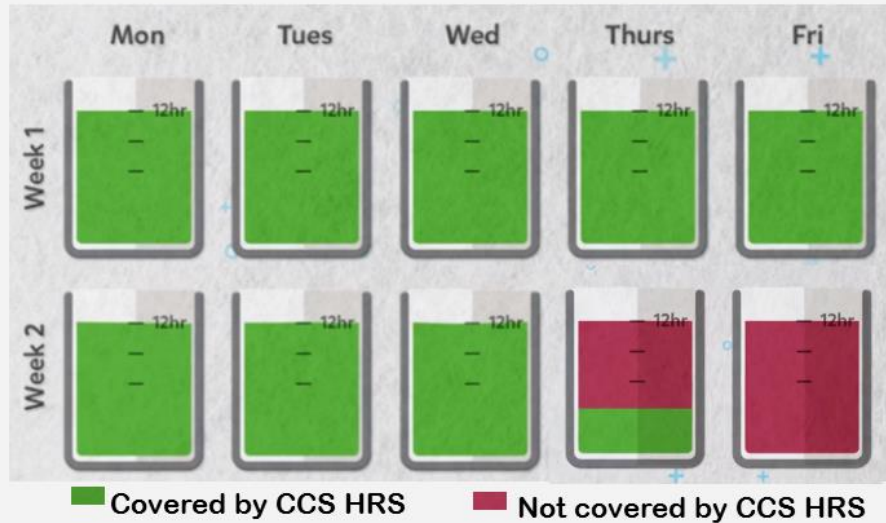

The Smith family receive :



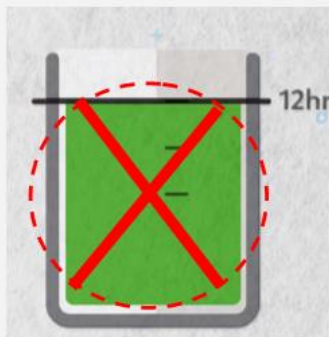

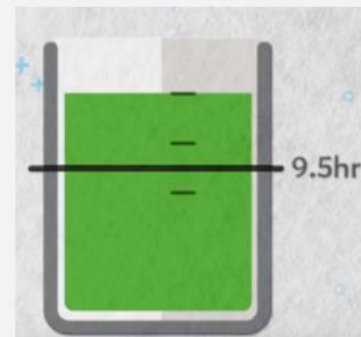
The Smith's two children attend 5 days a week

Since they receive 100 hours a fortnight, on an all day session of 12 hours, they will end up paying full price for 20 hours of childcare each fortnight for each child

Choosing the right session

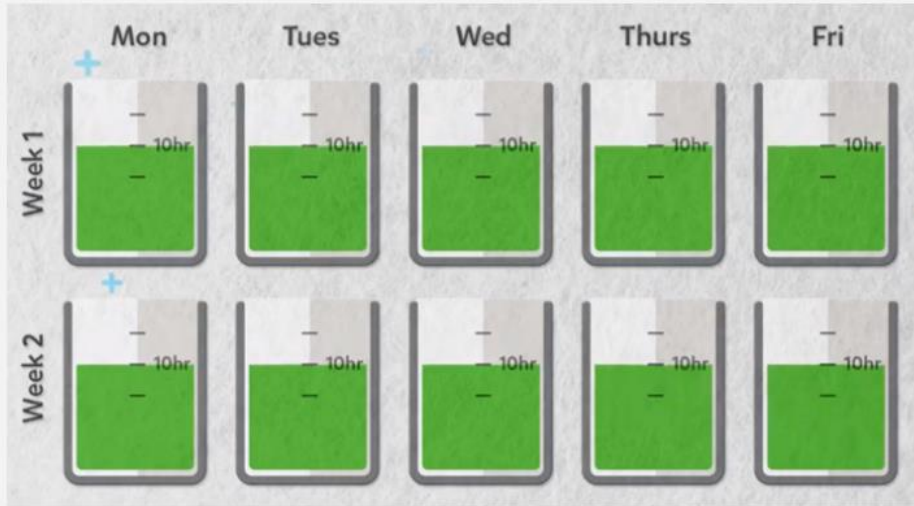


The Smith's two children aren't actually in care for 12 hours a day.

By choosing the 10 hour sessions that Academy for Early Learners offers, the Smith's 100 hour subsidy spreads out over the entire 10 days in the fortnight



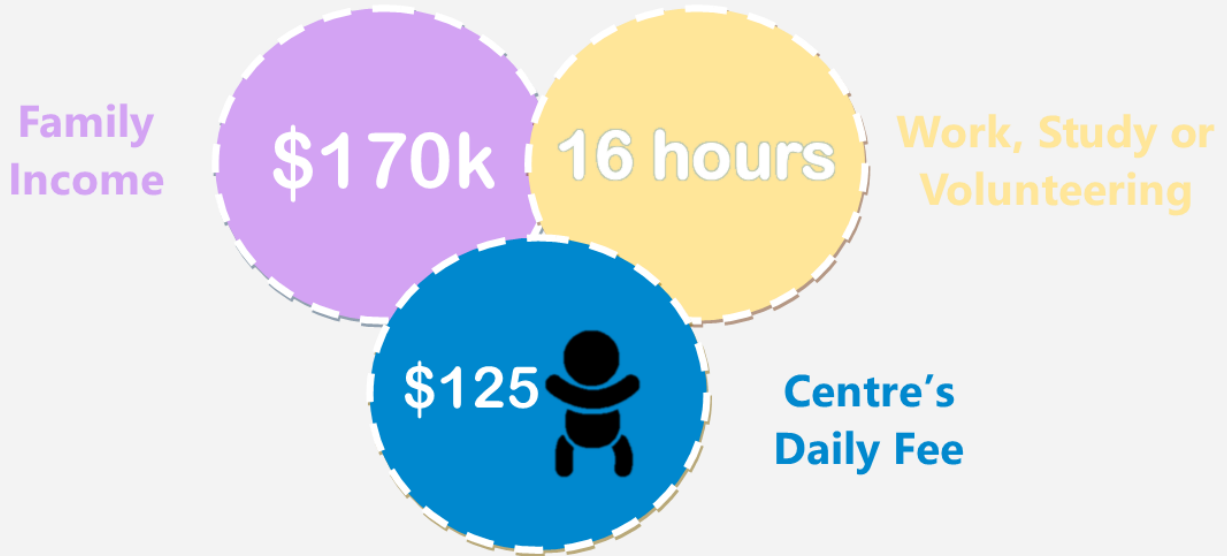

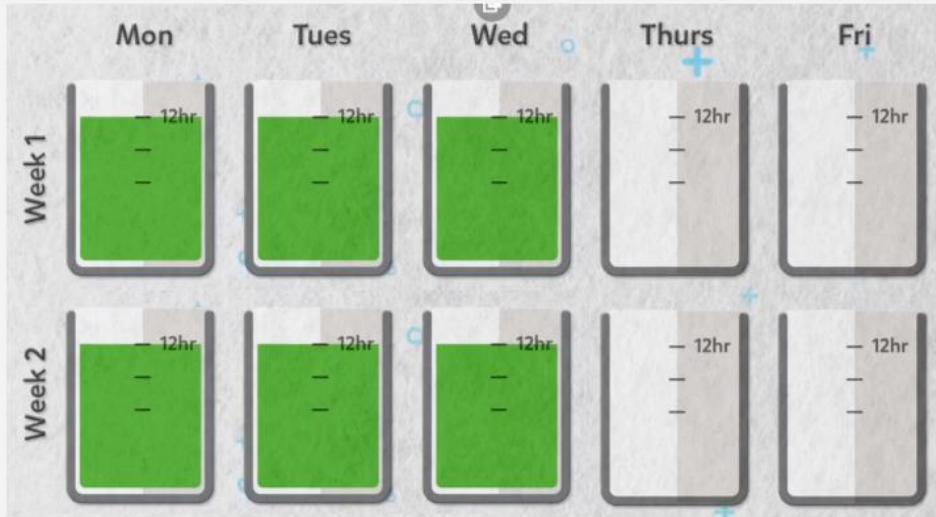

The Young family receive :

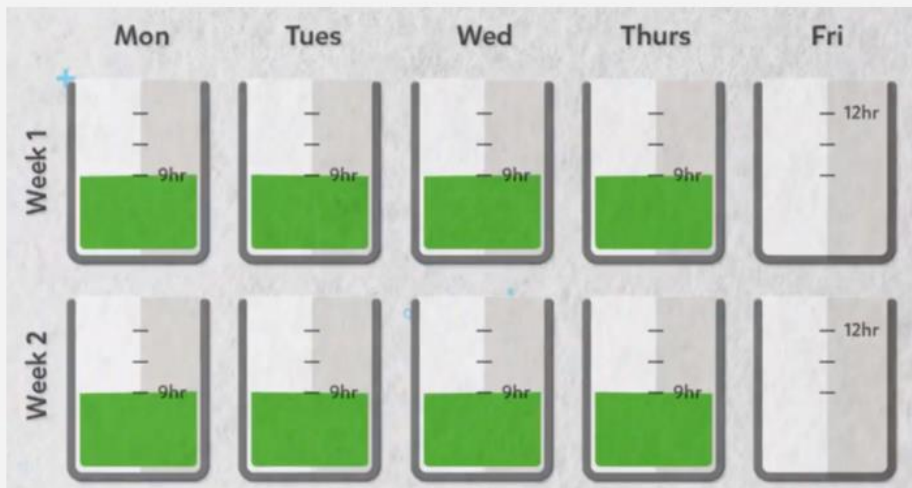

The Young's baby Tim attends 3 days a week

At a childcare centre that only offers 12 hour days, their subsidised hours only cover 3 days a week



By instead using Academy for Early Learners 9 hour sessions, their subsidy will cover 4 days of childcare

Please note: Scenarios are provided as a guide only. Child Care Subsidy eligibility vary based on each individual family circumstance.

The 9-hour and 10-hour sessions offered, along with the 'all day' session allows you to pay for the session you need.

✚ For families with preschool/kindergarten aged children who receive **less than 36 hours** of subsidy a fortnight
